PRAYER OF CONFESSION

The Congregation

Oh, that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down! That the mountains might shake at Your presence—as fire burns brushwood, as fire causes water to boil—to make Your name known to Your adversaries, *that* the nations may tremble at Your presence...For since the beginning of the world *Men* have not heard nor perceived by the ear, nor has the eye seen any God besides You, who acts for the one who waits for Him. You meet him who rejoices and does righteousness, *who* remembers You in Your ways. You are indeed angry, for we have sinned—in these ways we continue; and we need to be saved. But we are all like an unclean *thing*, and all our righteousnesses *are* like filthy rags; we all fade as a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. And *there is* no one who calls on Your name, who stirs himself up to take hold of You; for You have hidden Your face from us, and have consumed us because of our iniquities. But now, O LORD, You *are* our Father; we *are* the clay, and You our potter; And all we *are* the work of Your hand. Do not be furious, O LORD, Nor remember iniquity forever; Indeed, please look—we all *are* Your people! Amen.
